Aquatic Adventures -

After an introduction to aquatic insect adaptations, campers will create their own aquatic insect and see how it survives in the Middle Loup River habitat. Afterwards, they will build their own mini aquifer and then run pollution experiments with their models.

Career Education —

Careers in natural resources conservation, management, research and technology will be introduced to campers through an interactive presentation provided by a representative of the University of Nebraska--Lincoln.

Forestry - Within the setting of a state forest, campers will learn to use GPS units to locate particular trees within the camp area. Using tree identification skills acquired earlier, they will then identify the trees they locate.

Junk Art -Junk Art allows the creative mind to explore while building one-of-kind pieces of art using recycled materials. Campers will learn about "Reducing, Reusing, and Recycling". A friendly competition will pair campers together in teams, and all art work will be judged at the end of camp.

Activities

Halsey 4H Camp Activities -

Experience some of the wonders of camp at Halsey like archery, water slide, canoeing, climbing, repelling, and a River Stomp may be a new adventure for you to try.

Range and Grassland - Long known as "Cattle Country" in the heart of Nebraska, campers will explore the grasslands of the Sandhills and get up close and personal with many range plant species with the help of a Range Scientist.

Soils and Land - Play in the dirt! Campers will examine up close the different levels of soil in the Nebraska Sandhills. Afterwards, they will see firsthand how rain can affect the different soils found in Nebraska.

Wildlife - Campers take a hands-on role in learning about Nebraska's native wildlife. Learn about wildlife in every form, from those that fly above to those that burrow under the ground, in a variety of fun-filled educational activities.
